## Danny's Story

Janet and Danny were enjoying a special vacation in Hawaii with their son Joey, daughter Allison, and Janet's sister Sherry's entire family. They spent an awesome week of sun, fun, snorkeling, a luau and lots more....

From Allison: "My family and I were on vacation in Hawaii when my dad suffered a massive stroke (on June 2<sup>nd</sup>), causing a massive brain bleed. (He is hospitalized at Adventist Castle Health Center). The neurosurgeon removed half of his skull to allow room for swelling, and he has been in a coma for 2 weeks. He has made a lot of positive baby steps, but it will be weeks possibly months before we have any idea what damage has been done to his brain. We will now be in Hawaii for a few months waiting to see if he will recover. With both of my parents out of work we are scared for the expense of living here, our bills at home, and the pending medical bills. .... We are thankful for any financial help at all, but mostly just asking for prayers that he will wake up from this coma soon, and will recover with as little deficit as possible."

Our food pantry is very low on items to give to families in need. Please consider purchasing one or more of the following items when doing your weekly shopping:

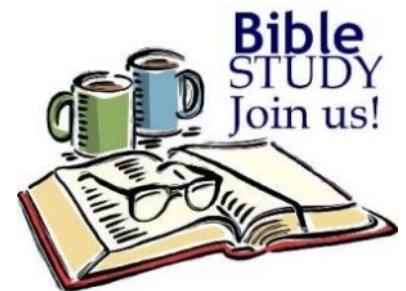

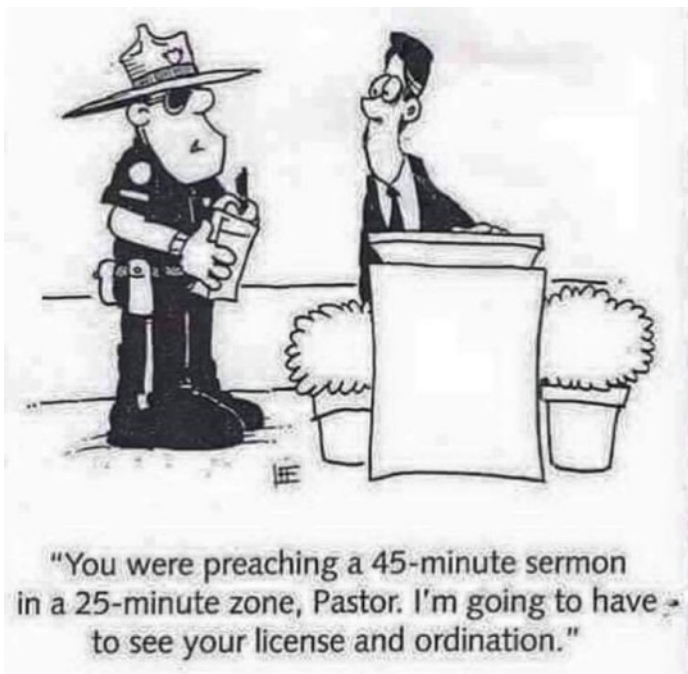
